Letter from Mayor Lane

Dear Resident,

The loud music on Wednesday night was coming from the Bunker Hill section of Paterson. I have notified other authorities who have jurisdiction in that area and hopefully the loud music will cease.

The first hearing for the Goffle Road project was last Tuesday, and we heard from the engineer and architect. The next hearing will be on March 15, where we will continue to hear testimony. The meeting is open to the public and starts at 7pm in the Courtroom.

The NPP Coordinator has filed with the State for their comments and approval the Implementation Plan created by the committee members. The NPP Committee will present the plan at the March 15 council meeting for the council and the public. You are invited to attend. I will update you when we hear back from the State.
