### Letter from Mayor Lane

Dear Resident,

We received our numbers from the County; the tax bills are being printed, and it is expected that they will be mailed on or about August 3, 2022. As per NJSA 54:4-66, et seq., no interest will be charged up to the 25<sup>th</sup> calendar day after the date the tax bill was mailed. The grace period has been extended by me and the Council to August 31, 2022. Please note that should your taxes be paid after August 31, then interest will be charged going back to August 1.

There are postcards being placed in our mail boxes that say that Hawthorne Water is having issues, and it instructs residents to telephone them to correct the problem. The Borough of Hawthorne did not send these cards out. Please disregard.

The newly painted curbs in some of residential areas are being stripped of the yellow paint, and the curbs will be repainted with a 'cement' colored paint.

The Committee is working on finalizing the "Name the Park" contest, and the NPP Committee is working on ideas for a mural on the grounds. I will have more to report at a later date.
