- I. Attendance and Acceptance of Minutes –July 2009 – not approved by Environmental Commission
- II. Water Report Update – month of July 2009 reviewed and discussed. All water results are fine, below NJDEP water quality standards.

  - a. Patriot Development – Board of Adjustment Monday August 17, 2009 presentation – Phil Savoie provided the site plans for Patriot Development for the Environmental Commission to review and discuss. Patriot Development is requesting nine (9) variances, including steep slope. Proposal for 20 townhouses and 7 single family homes on 6.64 acres of property. The Commission agreed that Mary Mahon will attend the Board of Adjustment meeting and provide Commission updates. The Environmental Commission plans to send comments to the Board of Adjustment regarding proposal.
