

ORDINANCE NO. 2196-17

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 505, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III, SECTION 505-21, TIME LIMIT PARKING, SCHEDULE XVI, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE SO AS TO ADD THERETO CERTAIN ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Chapter 505, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Section 505-21, Time Limit Parking, Schedule XVI, Section 505-69, shall be amended to add thereto the following additional locations:

Sec. 505-69 Schedule XVI: Time Limit Parking

In accordance with the provisions of Section 505-21, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit set forth below at any time between the listed hours upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Time Limit Hours/Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
Central Avenue	South	30 Minutes 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	20 feet from the easterly edge of the driveway apron at 226 Central Avenue, a distance of 40 feet to the east to a point 25 feet from the curb return at Forest Avenue

Section 2. All other parts and provisions of Section 505 and Schedule XVI not specifically affected by the above amendments and modifications shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption and publication as provided by law.
