

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE
PASSAIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

Sealed bids will be received by the Borough of Hawthorne, 445 Lafayette Avenue, Hawthorne, New Jersey 07506 in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey on March 12, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. prevailing time, and then publicly opened and read aloud for:

**SANITARY FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT AT GOFFLE HILL ROAD
BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE
PASSAIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

The work to be performed under this contract includes the following: a) Construction of approximately 2,500 L.F. of 6" D.I.P. sanitary force main along Goffle Hill Road from Goffle Pump Station #1 to an existing sanitary manhole located at the intersection of Goffle Hill Road and Cider Mill Road, b) Construction of approximately 650 L.F. of 4" D.I.P. sanitary force main along Sicomac Road from Sicomac Pump Station to proposed 6" D.I.P. sanitary force main at the intersection of Goffle Hill Road. c) Milling, resurfacing and striping of Goffle Hill Road within project limits. The proposed 6" and 4"D.I.P. force mains will replace the old force mains currently existing at the same road location respectively. The old force mains will be abandoned in place.

Principal items of work in the project include:

- 1 L.S. Locating Existing Force mains
- 100 C.Y. Rock Excavation
- 30 C.Y. Excavation, Test Pits
- 6,890 S.Y. Milling, 2" Depth
- 870 Tons Hot Mix Asphalt Surface Course
- 650 L.F. 4" Ductile Iron Force Main
- 2,500 L.F. 6" Ductile Iron Force Main
- 6 L.F. 8" Ductile Iron Sewer Pipe
- 1 Unit Manholes, Sanitary Sewer, with Drop Connections
- 1 L.S. Connecting New Force Mains to Pump Stations
- 24 Unit Water Service Restorations
- 24 Unit Gas Service Restorations
- 7700 L.F. Traffic Markings, Lines, Long Life, Epoxy Resin, 6" Width

The work contemplated under this Contract shall be completed within **90** calendar days from the date of execution of the Contract.

This project is funded in part by the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust and the successful bidder must comply with all the provision of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et. seq. for the participation of (SED's).

Copies of plans, specification, and contract documents will be on file for public inspection and may be obtained upon payment of \$125.00 at Boswell Engineering, 330 Phillips Avenue, South Hackensack, New Jersey 07606, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. prevailing time, Monday through Friday, excluding legal holidays. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:11-24(b), if for any reason, the contract is not awarded, refunds of the bidding documents fee will be returned to bidders when the contract

documents are returned in reasonable condition within 90 days of notice that the contract has not been awarded.

Each bid must be made upon the prescribed forms, furnished with the Contract Drawings and Specifications, including the non-collusion affidavit and disclosure statement and must be accompanied by a Consent of Surety and a certified check, cashier's check, or Bid Bond of not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount bid and, not to exceed \$20,000.00. Such checks and Bonds shall be made payable to the Owner and will be held as a Guarantee that in the event the Bid is accepted and a Contract awarded to the bidder, the Contract shall be duly executed and its performance properly secured. The successful bidder shall furnish and deliver to the Owner a performance and payment bond in the amount of 100 percent of the accepted bid amount as security for the faithful performance and payment of the Contract.

Further, the successful bidder must furnish the policies or Certificates of Insurance required by the Contract. In default thereof, said checks and the amount represented thereby will be forfeited to the aforesaid Owner as liquidated damages. Bids must be accompanied, in the case of corporations not chartered in New Jersey, by proper certificate that such corporation is authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey.

All corporations and partnerships must comply with Chapter 33, of the P.L. of 1977, regarding disclosure of partners and stockholders. Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, addressed to the Owner and labeled for the **NJEIT 2009 SANITARY FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT AT GOFFLE HILL ROAD AND SICOMAC ROAD.**

This contract is expected to be funded in part with the funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust (NJEIT). Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10.

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all the provisions of prevailing wage rates as determined by the New Jersey Department of Labor. A copy of the prevailing wage rates are on file for public inspection at Boswell Engineering, 330 Phillips Avenue, South Hackensack, New Jersey 07606, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. prevailing time, Monday through Friday, excluding legal holidays.

All bid security, except for the security of three apparent lowest responsible bidders, shall be returned, unless otherwise requested by the bidder, within 10 days after the opening of the bids as per L.P.C. 40A:11-23.

All bids shall be irrevocable, not subject to withdrawal and shall stand available for a period of sixty (60) days in accordance with L.P.C. 40A:11-24. The Owner and Bidder may agree to hold bids for consideration for a longer period of time, in accordance with the Local Public Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities in the bids received and to accept the bid from the lowest responsible bidder as per L.P.C. 40A:11-6.1.
