

ORDINANCE NO. 2027-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-10 TO FIX THE SALARIES, WAGES AND COMPENSATION OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

The Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne in the County of Passaic and the State of New Jersey, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2020-10, heretofore adopted on July 7, 2010, shall be and hereby amended therefore so as to read as follows:

SALARY ORDINANCE 2010

Section 2. As per agreement with Local 200, officers promoted to the ranks of Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain between the effective date of this ordinance and December 31, 2010 shall be paid at the salary shown in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2020-10 for the lower rank previously held up and until July 1, 2011.

Section 3. Except as herein amended, Ordinance No.2020-10 remains in full force and effect.

Section 4. All ordinance and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage, provided notice of the same has been duly published all as required by law.
