- Proof of Residency - Valid Driver's License and any of the following: signed lease or rental agreement (tenants), current property tax bill (owners), current utility bill, or bank statement. ALL DOCUMENTS MUST SHOW YOUR CURRENT HAWTHORNE ADDRESS.

Resident Parking Permits allow residents to park a vehicle in the designated Resident Restricted Parking Area between the hours of 9am and 10 am, Monday through Friday, except holidays.

Resident Parking Permit Fee is \$2.00 per year (January 1st - December 31st).

Parking Stickers must be displayed in the rear side window of the vehicle on the driver's side and shall be clearly visible from the outside of the vehicle.

No vehicle shall remain parked in any designated parking area for more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.

Vehicles must be parked within the duly marked or identified parking stalls. Parking is on a first-come, first-serve basis; a residential parking permit does not guarantee or reserve a parking place.

Any person requesting a Replacement Sticker will be required to submit vehicle documentation, the originally issued parking sticker and pay a replacement fee of \$2.00. Leased or company vehicles must be principally garaged at your Hawthorne address. You must present a letter from your company, on company letterhead, including the name, title, and phone number of your supervisor, stating that the vehicles has been assigned to you and that you maintain control over the vehicle at all times.

Any person who has purchased a parking permit may apply for a Temporary Parking Sticker for use in a vehicle other than the vehicle originally registered in circumstances where said vehicle is unavailable and an alternate vehicle is to be utilized. Temporary Parking Stickers shall be issued for a period not to exceed one week, but may be renewed weekly upon submission of an application and the payment of the associated fee. The fee for a temporary resident parking permit will be \$2.00 for each week or portion thereof.

Any person who is not entitled to receive a Resident Sticker or who utilizes any Resident Restricted Parking Area as a resident and who shall wrongfully affix or display a Resident Parking sticker to his or her vehicle and park within the Resident Restricted Parking Area during restricted hours, or shall knowingly and intentionally provide, assist, or transfer a Resident or Non-Resident Parking sticker to a person not entitled to utilize the same, shall be punished by a fine, upon conviction, in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 per offense.

Any vehicle found to be wrongfully or illegally parked in any Resident Restricted or Non-Resident Commuter Parking Area during the restricted hours or not parked within the stalls designated for parking within such areas, shall be towed and stored, at the expense of the owner and subject to any applicable fine.

Permit fees are non-refundable and permits cannot be transferred to another person. Permits are sold Monday-Friday 9:00am-4:00pm
