

BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE — *2022 *LEAF SCHEDULE



* For safety and efficiency, we encourage residents to use brown paper leaf bags or barrels instead of raking leaves into the streets. **The Borough will provide three (3) ways for RESIDENTS to dispose of leaves:**

- 1) Bag your leaves for weekly collection on your "yard waste" day collected by GAETA Co.** Starting Tuesday, November 1st you may put your leaves to the curb on your regular yard waste collection day in six (6) barrels or (6) brown paper bags. NO PLASTIC BAGS will be allowed.
- and / or -
- 2) Bring your leaves to the Recycling Center.**
 - ◆ The center is open from 8:30am until 4:00pm, Monday through Saturday
- and / or -
- 3) Rake your leaves to the curb per the following DPW Schedule below:**
 - ◆ Not Closer than 15 Feet to any Storm Drain
 - ◆ Leaves can be raked to the curb a week before your scheduled date.
 - ◆ The leaf collection schedule can be changed due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown and emergencies.
 - ◆ This schedule will start picking up on the street on the week of 10/24



*** FREE BAG PROGRAM**

- ◆ Beginning the week of October 24th and continuing through the month of November, residents with proof of residency, will be able to pick up their 15 free leaf bags from the Recycling Center, **** WHILE SUPPLIES LAST. ****
- ◆ Free bags will NOT be given out at the Municipal Building.
- ◆ Additional / Off Season Bags can be purchased - 3 for \$1.00

Please note: DPW will collect your leaves at curbside by WARD / ZONE. The Leaf Schedule can change due to: weather conditions, equipment breakdown & emergencies.

Please Note:

ALL LANDSCAPERS MUST REGISTER THEIR TRUCK(S) IN THE DPW OFFICE in the Municipal Building to obtain a PERMIT STICKER.

This sticker entitles you to dispose of leaves at the Borough compost site.

Permit Stickers are to be put in the front left/drivers-side window.

If you are in WARDS / ZONE :	Your leaves will be collected at the curb the following weeks:
ALL THROUGHOUT TOWN	WEEK OF 10/24 (spot piles)
WARD / ZONE 1	WEEK OF 10/31 and WEEK OF 11/28
WARD / ZONE 3	WEEK OF 11/07 and WEEK OF 12/05
WARD / ZONE 2	WEEK OF 11/14 and WEEK OF 12/12
WARD / ZONE 4	WEEK OF 11/21 and WEEK OF 12/19
ALL THROUGHOUT TOWN	WEEK OF 12/26 (spot piles)

* Please refrain from calling the DPW Office about the leaf schedule. The DPW is collecting leaves each week for two (2) months.
