

**BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE (1604)
Descriptions of New Ward Boundaries
January 14, 2022**

The following data resources were provided by the NJDEP Stream centerlines 2015; NJDOT Street centerlines 2015; TeleAtlas Street centerlines 2010. The parcels (2021) were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the New Jersey Geographic Information Network (NJGIN). The municipal boundaries 2021, were provided and referenced as the interpretation made by the NJ Office of GIS. This source data was utilized for the preparation of the ward district word description as stipulated under N.J.S.A. 40:44-15 (L. 1981, c. 496, s. 7, eff. Jan. 12, 1982) for submission to the Office of the New Jersey Secretary of State (SOS).

The Borough of Hawthorne in the County of Passaic in the State of New Jersey is comprised of a total of Four (4) Wards. Due to population changes and other concerns documented during Census 2020, new boundaries for these wards are required to meet Title 40, 40A (Municipalities, Counties) guidelines and the Township's current needs. The new boundaries for these wards are described herein.

Ward One

The First Ward of the Borough of Hawthorne shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Prescott Avenue is intersected by the centerline of the Passaic River (a waterway), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the City of Paterson, Passaic County and the Borough of Prospect Park, Passaic County shared border;

Thence, Northwest then Northeast, following along the physical centerline of Prescott Avenue, which is the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Prospect Park, Passaic County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of North Haledon, Passaic County shared border;

Continue, Northeast, following along the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of North Haledon, Passaic County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the extended physical centerline of Alana Drive;

Thence, East, following along the extended physical centerline of Alana Drive, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Metro Vista Drive;

Thence, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of Metro Vista Drive, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Hillock Avenue;

Thence, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of Hillock Avenue, to a point where said boundary is intersected by the extended physical centerline of Lynack Road;

Thence, Southeasterly, following along the extended physical centerline of Lynack Road, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Goffle Road (County Route 659);

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Goffle Road (County Route 659), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Warburton Avenue (County Route 710);

Ward One (cont'd)

Thence, Easterly, following along the physical centerline of Warburton Avenue (County Route 710), crossing over the centerline of Goffle Brook (a waterway), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665);

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Wagaraw Road (County Route 504);

Thence, East, following along the physical centerline of Wagaraw Road (County Route 504), to a point where said boundary intersects the centerline of Conrail-Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Company, Paterson & Ramapo Branch-Main Line (a railroad);

Thence, Southwest, following along the centerline of Conrail-Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Company, Paterson & Ramapo Branch-Main Line (a railroad), to a point where said boundary intersects the centerline of the Passaic River (a waterway), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the City of Paterson, Passaic County shared border;

Thence, Southeasterly, various courses, following along the centerline of the Passaic River (a waterway), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the City of Paterson, Passaic County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Prescott Avenue, which is also a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the City of Paterson, Passaic County and the Borough of Prospect Park, Passaic County shared border and is also the point of beginning.

Ward Two

The Second Ward of the Borough of Hawthorne shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of Parker Avenue is intersected by the physical centerline of Lincoln Avenue (County Route 69), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Glen Rock, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of Lincoln Avenue (County Route 69), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Glen Rock, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the centerline of the Passaic River (a waterway), which is also a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Fair Lawn, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, Southeasterly, various courses, following along the centerline of the Passaic River (a waterway), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Fair Lawn, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the centerline of Conrail-Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Company, Paterson & Ramapo Branch-Main Line (a railroad), which is also a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the City of Paterson, Passaic County shared border;

Thence, Northerly, following along the centerline of Conrail-Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Company, Paterson & Ramapo Branch-Main Line (a railroad), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Wagaraw Road (County Route 504);

Ward Two (cont'd)

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Wagaraw Road (County Route 504), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665);

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Rea Avenue (County Route 664);

Thence, West, following along the extended physical centerline of Rea Avenue (County Route 664), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Fifth Avenue;

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline Fifth Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of physical centerline of Parker Avenue;

Thence, East, following along the physical centerline of Parker Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of physical centerline of Lincoln Avenue (County Route 69), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Glen Rock, Bergen County shared border, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Three

The Third Ward of the Borough of Hawthorne shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the extended physical centerline of Alana Drive is intersected by the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of North Haledon, Passaic County shared border;

Thence, Northerly, following along the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of North Haledon, Passaic County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County shared border;

Continue, Northeast then Southeast, following along the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 208;

Thence, Southeasterly, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 208, to a point where said boundary intersects with the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665);

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Warburton Avenue (County Route 710);

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Warburton Avenue (County Route 710), crossing over the centerline of Goffle Brook (a waterway), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Goffle Road (County Route 659);

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of Goffle Road (County Route 659), to a point where said boundary is intersected by the physical centerline of Lynack Road;

Ward Three (cont'd)

Thence, Northeasterly, following along the extended physical centerline of Lynack Road, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Hillock Avenue;

Continue, Southerly, following along the physical centerline of Hillock Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Metro Vista Drive;

Thence, Northerly, following along the physical centerline of Metro Vista Drive, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Alana Drive;

Thence, Northwesterly, following along the extended physical centerline of Alana Drive, to a point where said boundary intersects with a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of North Haledon, Passaic County shared border, which is also the point of beginning.

Ward Four

The Fourth Ward of the Borough of Hawthorne shall include all of the territory and inhabitants thereof contained, in an area which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 208 is intersected by the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, Southeast, following along the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Village of Ridgewood, Bergen County shared border;

Continue, Southeast, following along the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Village of Ridgewood, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Lincoln Avenue (County Route 69);

Thence, South, following along the physical centerline of Lincoln Avenue (County Route 69), which is also the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Glen Rock, Bergen County shared border, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Parker Avenue, which is also another point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Borough of Glen Rock, Bergen County shared border;

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline Parker Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Fifth Avenue;

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of Fifth Avenue, to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Rea Avenue (County Route 664);

Thence, West, following along the physical centerline of Rea Avenue (County Route 664), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665);

Thence, North, following along the physical centerline of Lafayette Avenue (County Route 665), to a point where said boundary intersects the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 208;

Ward Four (cont'd)

Thence, Northwesterly, following along the physical centerline of New Jersey State Highway Route 208, to its point of intersection with a point on the Borough of Hawthorne, Passaic County and the Township of Wyckoff, Bergen County shared border; which is also the point of beginning.

The Borough of Hawthorne is currently located in Legislative District Thirty-Eight and Congressional District Nine.
