KEEP YOURSELF AND YOUR PROPERTY CLEAN • Sweep regularly. • Clean up spills immediately. • Don't pour oil, paint, or other liquids down the drain.	WHAT IS STORMWATER POLLUTION? • Stormwater is rain or melted snow that runs off roofs, streets, parking lots, and other paved areas. It picks up dirt, oil, and other pollutants as it flows.	WASH YOUR CAR PROPERLY • Wash your car in a car wash or a designated area. • Don't use a hose to wash your car on the street.
DON'T FEED WILDLIFE • Don't feed birds or other wildlife. • Use bird feeders responsibly.	A GUIDE TO READY MADE PDS CLEANER WASH • Use Ready Made Cleaner Wash (RMCW) for cleaning cars, boats, and other outdoor equipment. • RMCW is a biodegradable, phosphate-free detergent that is safe for the environment.	PROPERLY USE AND DISPOSE OF AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTS • Don't pour oil, antifreeze, or other fluids down the drain. • Use oil change services that have proper disposal facilities.
